SECURITY VERIFICATION FOR THE OPENING OF MINISTERIAL SEGMENT

The opening ceremony of the Ministerial Segment of the 66th Session of the ESCAP will be held at 0920 hours on Monday, 17 May 2010 in the Premier Ballroom A/B, 2nd floor, Songdo ConvensiA.

To ensure safety and security for the VVIPs attending the opening as well as for all participants, the Security Service of the Presidential Office of the ROK will undertake security verification for all personnel, entering the conference area in the Songdo ConvensiA in the morning of 17 May 2010 in ConvensiA before the security check point.

In this connection, it is requested that all delegates attending the 66th Session of ESCAP **bring with them their passports** on 17 May 2010 and show them to the security staff at the security verification point. Once cleared, the security staff will issue a special security sticker to each participant which is required for entering the conference area beyond the security checkpoint and the Ballroom A/B where the opening will be held.

For the heads of delegations of ESCAP members and associate members wearing badges in red color, the security verification mentioned above will not be required. Instead, they will be provided with a security sticker when they pass through the special security check passage.

The security verification to be undertaken by the Security Service of the Presidential Office of the ROK will start at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, 17 May 2010. In order to avoid congestion and ensure the opening of the Ministerial Segment is held as scheduled, **participants are kindly requested to arrive at Songdo ConvensiA as early as possible, but prior to 0850 hours at the latest, and to be seated in the Premier Ballroom A/B by 0910 hours.**
